The purpose of this Letter to Commission is to invite you to join us for Bike to School Day on May 4, 2016 at any of the following school presentations:

- Fienberg Fisher K-8 Center 1:15 pm
- Nautilus Middle School 3:00 pm

Students from Fienberg Fisher K-8 Center will also participate in a school organized bike to school event from 11<sup>th</sup> Street and Meridian Avenue (Flamingo Park) beginning at 7:45 a.m..

Students at Miami Beach Senior High, Nautilus Middle School and Fienberg Fisher K-8 Center will attend a presentation by the City's Transportation Department and Police Department on the following:

- Riding a bicycle safely
- Tips for riding safely on roadways
- Instructions on how to effectively ride a bike on the streets (alone and in groups)

The Florida Department of Transportation District Six will be providing free bicycle lights (front and back), as well as bike safety pamphlets during the event. The University of Miami's Bike Safe staff will be in attendance to provide supplemental pertinent educational materials during the presentations. In addition, the Miami Beach Police Department will be assisting with registration of bikes on site.


