The purpose of this Letter to Commission (LTC) is to inform the Commission of an amendment to a resolution originally passed by the Human Rights Committee at their monthly July committee meeting and disseminated via LTC 309-2016.

The amended resolution, passed by the Human Rights Committee at their monthly October meeting, is as follows:

### **RESOLUTION 1:**

That the City allocate a recurring budgetary amount not to exceed \$5,000 to include, but not be limited to, funds for marketing, facilities and labor costs for an annual educational event to be presented by the Human Rights Committee.
