SUBJECT: Human Rights Committee Resolution

The purpose of this Letter to Commission (LTC) is to inform the Commission of a resolution passed by the Human Rights Committee at their monthly November committee meeting.

RESOLUTION 1:

It is the Committee's resolution that the City Commission adopt and expand the current Miami-Dade County Ordinance Sec. 21-31.5 regarding human trafficking awareness signs at adult entertainment, massage, and bodywork services establishments to include all Miami Beach establishments that are currently required to display the City Human Rights Ordinance poster. The Committee further recommends that the poster be required to be displayed prominently in all restrooms located within a facility. If no bathroom exists, the poster should be placed in a conspicuous location that is clearly visible to the public and employees of the establishment.

The Miami Beach Human Rights Committee urges the Mayor and Commission to support the aforementioned resolution.
