Who needs to disclose?

Any member of the City Commission who directly solicits gifts on behalf of a nonprofit organization from a vendor, lobbyist on a procurement issue, real estate developer and/or lobbyist on a real estate development issue. Section 2-461, Miami Beach City Code.

When does this form need to be filed?

The form shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk as a public record within 10 business days from the date in which the subject solicitation occurred.

Definitions:

- (1) The term "gift" shall have the meaning ascribed to such term in Miami-Dade County Code Section 2-11.1(e).
- (2) The term "nonprofit organization" shall have the meaning ascribed to such term in Miami-Dade County Code Section 2-11.1(e)(2)(g) and shall mean any entity described in sections 501(c)(3) and 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Code") that is tax exempt under section 501(a) of the Code.
- (3) The terms "vendor," "lobbyist on a procurement issue," "real estate developer" or "lobbyist on a real estate development issue," shall have the meaning ascribed to such terms in Chapter 2, Article VII, Division 5 of the Miami Beach City Code.
