

## COVID-19 DAILY SCREENING & TEMPERATURE CHECK POLICY

In order to mitigate and prevent the spread of the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, the City of Miami Beach has put in place a daily health screening and temperature check policy for your child.

Upon arrival to your child's summer care facility, you will be asked to answer the following set of questions in addition to having your child's temperature taken:

1. Does your child present symptoms of a fever, shortness of breath or cough?
2. Have you or your child returned from international travel or a cruise within the last 14 days and have any symptoms of a fever, shortness of breath or cough?
3. Have you had contact with anyone who has confirmed COVID-19 or who is awaiting lab results to rule out COVID-19 within the last 14 days?

The employee will then evaluate the answers to the questionnaire. If any of the answers to the questions on the questionnaire are, "Yes," your child will be prohibited from entering the building or program, unless cleared by a doctor. If all the answers to the questionnaire are, "No," the employee will proceed to administer a temperature scan to the enrolled child using a handheld no touch thermometer. The employee will also do a visual examination to make sure the child is not exhibiting any symptoms of sickness. Children who exhibit symptoms of an upper respiratory illness will not be permitted to attend the program that day.

If the participant's temperature is 100.4 or above, the participant will not be able to attend the program. If participant's temperature is under 100.4, then participant will be directed into the facility to disinfect their hands and join their group.

If you have any of the above symptoms or exposures, we ask that you do not attend any programming or visit any facility. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in helping us keep our youth, staff and communities safe.
