Indian Creek Drive Flooding Mitigation Phase III

Project Advisory - December 18, 2020

Project Overview and Benefits

This project delivers vital improvements to the Indian Creek Drive community by providing new sidewalks, a lighting system and a continuous delineated bicycle path. It will also address flooding within the neighborhood by installing a comprehensive stormwater drainage system, including a water treatment system and generator in case of a power outage. Additionally, the road and sidewalk will be rebuilt at a higher elevation to mitigate sea level rise.

What's Happening

No work is scheduled to be performed between December 24, 2020 and January 3, 2021. Work will resume on Monday, January 4, 2021.

The following activities are scheduled along Indian Creek Drive:

- Continuing to install inlets and minor drainage on side streets between 39 and 41 streets
- Continuing to pave along Indian Creek Drive between 36 and 37 streets, and along sections of 32 and 34 streets
- Continuing to install curb, sidewalk and perform harmonization work along the east side of Indian Creek Drive between 36 and 37 streets
- Cleaning and reviewing sections of the 72-inch drainage pipe along Indian Creek Drive

Harmonization continues at properties north of 36 Street.

Please note, the project team is closely monitoring the situation surrounding COVID-19. The contractor is enforcing strict social distancing measures and employees are using face covers while on site, including during break times.

IImeline

Construction work hours are weekdays from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Extended time is subject to city approval and community notification. Please note, this schedule could change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

This schedule may change due to unforeseen conditions or weather.

What to Expect

- Moderate levels of construction noise is expected during the day
- Construction equipment, machinery and workers will be present at work zone

An advisory will be issued every two weeks or as changes in the work takes place.
