## G.O. Bond #24: Middle Beach Beachwalk

*Project Update - Sept. 23, 2021*

### What's Happening

The City of Miami Beach is working diligently to open the remaining 11 street-ends between 24 and 45 streets as soon as it is safe to do so. This week, the street-ends located at 25 and 31 streets were reopened.

The following activities are in progress:

- Installation of landscaping, irrigation, pavers, lighting, benches and showers continue at various street-ends.
- The street-end on 26 Street serves as a temporary construction access point and will be the final to reopen.

### Project Benefits

This beachside amenity is part of the greater Atlantic Greenway Network (AGN), which aims to support the use of alternative modes of transportation along the Eastern Seaboard. The project replaces the prior raised wooden boardwalk in this area with an approximately 15-foot wide, on-grade, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-accessible paver pathway that supports bicycles, pedestrians and other nonmotorized modes of transportation.



The Middle Beach Beachwalk has been open from 24 to 45 streets since May 2021.

### What to Expect

Beach access is located at the following streets: 24, 25, 29, 30, 31, 32 and 36.

Temporary beach access is provided at 26, 27, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42 and 43 streets as some of these accesses may be closed intermittently to allow for work at the street-ends.

Please note that some areas in the work zone may not have workers present at all times due to the nature of the project.

### Timeline

The completion of the street-ends has been impacted by a shortage of materials and unforeseen site conditions. The project is scheduled for completion in January 2022, but every effort is being made to open up the remaining street-ends as soon as it is safe to do so.

Work hours are from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Extended hours and weekend work days are subject to city approval and community notification.
