1. Logic and Accuracy Test of the touch screen and optical scan voting systems to be used for Vote-by-Mail, early voting, and precinct ballots.

Action:

- a. On November 10, 2021, at approximately 2:10 p.m., the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections had the tabulating equipment to be used in the City of Miami Beach Run-Off Election publicly tested to ensure that equipment will correctly count the precinct and Vote-by-Mail ballots cast for all candidates, in all offices, in the Miami Beach Run-Off Election to be held on November 16, 2021.
- b. Public notice of the testing of the tabulating equipment (Logic and Accuracy Test) and the Canvassing Board Schedule for the November 16, 2021 City of Miami Beach Run-Off Election was published in the City's webpage, as well as in the Miami Herald and El Nuevo Herald on November 5, 2021.
- c. Rafael E. Granado, City Clerk, and Judy Hoanshelt, Qualified Miami Beach Elector, as representatives of the Canvassing Board, attended the public Logic and Accuracy Test, to certify the accuracy of the test and witness resetting and sealing of each device that passed to a preelection state of readiness in such a manner as to secure its state of readiness until the opening of the poll.
- d. The Logic and Accuracy Test was open to the public, political party representatives, and candidates or their representatives.
 - i. On August 30, 2021, September 30, 2021, and November 3, 2021 the City Clerk sent via certified mail written notice of the Logic and Accuracy Test date, time, and location to the County party chair of each political party and all candidates.

- e. Rafael E. Granado and Judy Hoanshelt observed the performance and results of all required tests and verified the correctness of the programs and equipment, as well as any replacement of said materials required by said tests, subject to said tests. The Logic and Accuracy Test consisted of producing/processing a set of pre-determined valid votes for each candidate, as well as one or more under-voted and over-voted ballots for each contest.
- f. Upon satisfactorily completing the Logic and Accuracy Test, Rafael E. Granado and Judy Hoanshelt compared the test results with the predetermined totals for each candidate and/or measure pursuant to the requirements established in Section 101.5612, Florida Statutes. The expected vote counts matched the actual vote counts.
- g. After the test, there was delivered to Rafael E. Granado, in a sealed container with seal No. 0051621, the verified Logic and Accuracy Test reports, and test materials. Steps have been taken to ensure the security of said materials before, during, and after the election, except when said materials are properly in the possession of the Elections Department staff appointed to conduct the Miami Beach Run-Off Election.
- h. See Certification of Logic and Accuracy attached and incorporated hereto.

2. Vote-by-Mail Information:

As of November 10, 2021, Miami-Dade Elections Department delivered/mailed 15,846 Vote-by-Mail Ballots.

As of November 10, 2021, 15 Vote-by-Mail Ballots have been returned to the Miami-Dade County Elections Department.
