 - Trolley & Freebee Ridership Report: Alicia Fernandez Diaz, provided numbers
 - C. Esquivel: YTD ridership report to compare to prior year, as numbers are still small, and will Freebee still run after bus fare starts June 1st?

Jose Gonzalez will share ridership report (LTC) that contains this information with committee; Commission has directed to provide Freebee until September 30th and then come before Commission again to determine if to continue service or revert to original purpose – Middle Beach community on-demand transit

- A. Rabin: Bicycle safety questions, laws, etc.; Josiel Ferrer to send link to City's masterplan that has policies and rules, articles
 - Status on Pending TPBPFC Items/Requests: Josiel Ferrer briefed on items they have been working on
- A. Rabin: Sheridan/37th where to find information about things in progress (traffic circle, etc.); Josiel Ferrer will send presentation to be shared with committee
- JP Morgan: 83rd/Harding Ave there is a SR 441 sign; will send picture / Transportation to look at/arrange to remove
 - Update on Washington Ave Street Pilot:
- C. Esquivel: Status of pilot/feedback; Jose Gonzalez Master plan being conducted to look at different streets and reconfigurations and will be ready by July, then to City Commission

Looking at shared bus/bike lane concept on Washington; trying to keep parklets, bike lanes, bringing transit back and improve traffic flow

• Update on Better Bus Project:

C Esquivel: Salvage 150 / extending around Collins corridor; Jose Gonzalez – 150 being replaced with another route that will also go from airport to Miami Beach

C Bolado: Issue is it is one of the most expensive routes to run and ridership has not been worth it; Better Bus Project will replace it with another route via McArthur, South Beach, Omni, up to Airport and will run more frequently but take longer

Southbound Alton Delays & 43rd ST Light at Mt. Sinai:

M Edelstein: Southbound light at 43^{rd} /Alton, takes 4 light changes to get through – perfect opportunity for smart signal; Josiel Ferrer – recommendations have already been made to County. Infrastructure with signal is not working, working with the hospital project to expedite

Monica Beltran: 300 paystations brought back and parking revenue in general has improved; Collins Park Garage is also doing well

C. Esquivel: Are Lyft scooters from Dade County allowed on Miami Beach? Airbnb getting residential permits and taking up residential parking

Jose Gonzalez – scooters are not supposed to be on this side of bay and should be geo-fenced; report them when seen

Monica Beltran: Airbnb – not causing impact; these permits have not been issued in years and City has strict policy on Airbnb's. Will look at issue closer

B. Jacobs: Indian Creek project work hours issue; Claudia Wong will reach out to David Gomez/CIP

M. Edelstein: Venetian Causeway Improvement meeting; Josiel Ferrer – project development/environmental study of all twelve bridges on Venetian and appropriate course of treatment, looking at replacement, etc.
