- I. **Call to Order:** M. Edelstein, Chair, called meeting to order at 3:31 p.m.

- III. **Approval of September 13, 2021 Meeting Minutes:** *A. Feola moved to approve the minutes, seconded by B. Jacobs; minutes were unanimously approved.*
- IV. **Transportation Department Items:**

FDOT Update on the Design of Future Alton Road Projects in Mid-Beach: FDOT Rep: Natalie Garganta presented project scope/timeline; questions answered.

Washington Ave Interim Configuration: Presented by Josiel Ferrer and Jose Gonzalez/Transportation Department; will be sent to committee as well. Discussion held and questions answered; Item to be brought back in November; Public Works input on parklets.

43rd ST/Alton Traffic Light: M. Edelstein: Situation has worsened; Josiel Ferrer provided update – looking at more measured approach.

Follow up – Ocean Drive Concepts/100 Blocks: A. Feola: Residential parking should not be 24hrs, as there is still a need for regular parking.

Monica Beltran: All spaces on Ocean Drive were lost and Zone 5 residents can now park on Ocean Drive and spills onto Zone 2; will look at permits issued, talk to PD and will report back.

Upcoming Commission/Committee Items:

Status of Pending TPBPFC Items / Other Business: Jose Gonzalez briefed Committee on items.

E. Porcelli: Pilot of bicycles on Beachwalk; Josiel Ferrer - pilot will be from 15-24th and will be discussed at October 29th Neighborhood Community Affairs Committee meeting.

Milos Majstorovic: Reported that per P. Henao's request for more bike racks, some were installed on 75th/Ocean Terrace; 63rd ST., 46th ST., and will be doing walk-thru with her in North Beach to see where more are needed.

A. Feola: 8th/Ocean Drive bike rack is not necessary as there are some across street and should be relocated; Transportation will look at.

P. Henao: 63rd ST Bridge progress – traffic getting worse with bridge opening; Normandy Isle – surveyors and markings; Harding/Abbot configuration.

Josiel Ferrer: Normandy – being surveyed for GO Bond traffic calming project; Harding/Abbot – DOT has project in area.

63rd ST Bridge for next month agenda item.
