Subject: Community Service Hours

During the summer, Miami Beach Ocean Rescue will conduct beach and aquatic safety program for children. In Florida, drowning is the leading cause of accidental death for the 15th and under age group. The Jr Lifeguard Program is a summer camp for our community's children; its sole purpose is to educate children about Beach Safety, Injury Prevention and ultimately help reduce drowning in our area. Our mission is to provide the children of our community (8-13 years old) with a sound aquatic background, acquaint them with the hazard of ocean swimming while exposing them to an environment that will teach confidence and foster good sportsmanship. Our course gives children an opportunity to get hands on experience with hazard recognition and aquatic safety, identification of and experience around environmental hazard, review rescue equipment; demonstrate rescue techniques and teaches elementary first aid. Program content consist of ocean and beach safety, ecology and marine life, elementary first aid, and competition in real ocean lifeguard events.

This summer we will offer two sessions of young age groups:

Monday- Friday / three hours a day

1. Ages 8-10 from 9:00-12:00 noon
2. Ages 11-13 from 9:00-12:00 noon

We are interested in working with local high schools by participating in your student's Community Service Hours Program. We recognize that we could not have success in such program without the assistance of excellent swimming volunteers like your student-athletes. We are interested in utilizing community service students with experience and/or are outstanding aquatic athletes to supplement our group supervision and water surveillance. All students will be under the direct supervision of Ocean Rescue employees at all times. We are interested in students that are first and foremost aquatic athletes. Our program will need between 6-10 students each week. We need individuals that are dependable, willing to work the entire 5 days session and are punctual. We can not use individuals for an hour here, a day there. We need students that are reliable, can be counted on to do a task and will come in site ready to work hard. Our program director will have final decision as to community service student acceptance in this capacity. High School Community Service students are required to do the following:

1. Complete and submit registration form and indemnification agreement
2. Will report at 8:30am to South Pointe Park (playground area) , South Beach
3. From 8:30-9:00 help with equipment and supplies deployment, assist in preparation for the Program, set- up the course and field.

4. From 9:00-12:00 act as group counselor ; and mentor (additional water surveillance, participate in demonstration, assist group supervision, etc.)

5. From 12:00-12:30 assist in field breakdown and equipment storage

In return participants will receive :

1. Credited with four(4) service hours per day (8:30-12:30), twenty(20) service hours per week

2. Uniforms will be offered free of charge

3. Scholarship for our program if willing to participate

Miami Beach Ocean Rescue Jr. Lifeguard Program will fill the important roles of beach safety, injury prevention awareness and Community Education. Working together is good for the Community. The students will earn hours and benefit from the experience, extra responsibilities and skills learned. At the same time the partnership will provide students a means to meet needed requirements for graduation.
