- IX. Barbara – Borinquen Health Choice Network In kind services being provided; they have decided to upgrade to lpn model; involved parents; North Beach – 16/day – LPN + RN; Medical Assistant ->LPN +\$90,000; Skill level is reason; LPN would minimize 911 calls-chronic disease reponse – more students – medically involved; Health Foundation – Oral Health Care – 1/3 need dental care at RKB and NBE. We need to discuss how to get more dental care at other schools
- X. Alice Quarles – suggested bringing Borinquen to faculty and PTSA meetings for education; Barbara mentioned that the parents are amazing! Clinic reported close to 70% returned to class; "You can't mess with the Nurse!" We have a replicable model!
