Dear Honorable Mayor and City Commission:

On June 12<sup>th</sup>, the Transportation, Parking & Bicycle-Pedestrian Facilities Committee (TPBPFC) met and wishes to supplement LTC #274-2017, with the below unanimously passed motions from their meeting on May 8, 2017:

**Taxicab Stands**

The TPBPFC recommends the reduction of taxicab stands from three (3) to one (1) at the 100 block of 74<sup>th</sup> Street.

***Supplemental: The TPBPFC Committee recommends accepting the Parking Department's recommendation of 18 parking spaces to be reclaimed from taxicab stands.***

**Trolley – Venetian Link**

The TPBPFC recommends for a stop at Omni.

***Supplemental: The TPBPFC Committee recommends having a separate trolley route that connects Miami Beach, goes across the Venetian, with an ending point at Omni and returns to Miami Beach.***
