As you know, the November 6, 2018 General Election is quickly approaching! The Elections Department is encouraging our voters to "Be Election Ready." There are a lot of candidates and a minimum of 17 questions, depending on where you live, which means a very long ballot. Voters are urged to go online and review their [Customized Sample Ballot](#) before heading to the polls. This tool is extremely helpful as it gives voters the opportunity to view and/or print their specific ballot before they vote.

The comprehensive [Sample Ballot](#) is also available online. It contains a wealth of other important election information.

Voters don't have to wait until Election Day to vote. They can request a [Vote-by-Mail ballot](#). This is encouraged in this election due to the length of the ballot, and voters can take the time they need to review and understand the questions. Alternatively, voters who prefer to vote in person, are encouraged to go to one of the 28 conveniently located [Early Voting sites](#), from October 22 through November 4, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

If voting in person, we are strongly encouraging voters to print the sample ballot, make their selections, and bring it with them to the polls.

The Elections Department will continue to disseminate this important information through social media, local media venues, and our website. I am asking that you please also help us by disseminating this information to your networks. That would be of great help to us.

Being "Election Ready" by preparing in advance is critical in this election!
