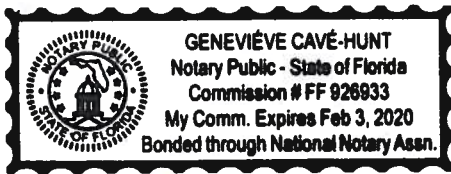



Letter of Interest

I have had the privilege to work in the environmental profession as a Senior Environmental Scientist, specializing in water resources, and a Stormwater Management Inspector in the South Florida area for a number of years. With this experience, I have recognized a desperate need for input from the scientific community on the decisions being made at the local level.

Our City of Miami Beach has developed a \$500 million dollar plan for mitigating the effects of sea level rise on our community, yet we do not have anyone with a scientific background serving as a City Commissioner. I have the educational background, and more importantly, the professional experience to effectively recognize the areas in which we need to focus our sea level rise mitigation efforts, and the potential environmental impacts that may result from the implementation of the existing plan.

Good Morning All

We have been encouraged by the Clerk's Office in the email below to reach out and get to know our Commissioners and Mayor on a more personal level to assist with the Group IV Commission Seat determination.

Some of you already know me, and others may be familiar with my name. My name is **Isaiah Mosley** and I ran for the Group IV Commission Seat during the 2015 election campaign. In 2015 I ran on the idea that we are to build the best team of individuals possible to represent the population of Miami Beach, while providing knowledge and insight from our personal experiences. Of the pool of candidates in consideration for this seat, I feel I best represent young professionals seeking healthy living, progression, and community involvement at the forefront of their life purpose.
