IV. Discussion on Commissioner Aleman's Proposed Changes to the TPBPFC Structure:
Discussion held and motion passed regarding the proposed changes to the structure of the committee which is being proposed as follows (underline denotes additions; ~~strike through~~ denotes deletions):

The committee shall consist of ~~14~~ 11 voting members. The mayor and city commissioners shall each make one direct appointment, with the other ~~seven~~ four members of the committee to be comprised of members from the following community organizations, each of which ~~must delegate a permanent coordinating representative whom shall be appointed by majority vote of the city commission:~~

- 1) Miami Beach Chamber of Commerce's Transportation and Parking Committee;
- 2) ~~Miami Beach Community Development Corporation;~~ A South Beach neighborhood or business association;
- 3) ~~Ocean Drive Association;~~
- 4) ~~Miami Design Preservation League;~~
- 5) ~~North Beach Development Corporation;~~
- 6) ~~(3) A Mid-Beach neighborhood or business association;~~
- 7) ~~Lincoln Road Marketing, Inc.~~
- 4) A North Beach neighborhood or business association.

R. Breslin moved that the Transportation, Parking and Bicycle-Pedestrian Facilities Committee asks the Mayor & Commission to pull this item from the January 16, 2019 Commission agenda, and that a clear definition be provided as to the reasons why these proposed changes have been brought up and requested; seconded by JP Morgan, all in favor/none opposed - motion passed (LTC #026-2019)

Resident Brian Harris addressed Committee and asks for reevaluation of loops

R. Breslin moved that the TPBPFC Committee for the third time is asking the Mayor & Commission look into the Belle Isle Loop being over serviced, and the reason why the Transit Alliance voted the City of Miami Beach a four (4) instead of five (5). The Committee would like this reevaluated to add more service to the South Beach A & B which are under serviced; seconded by A. Ferreira de Melo, all in favor/none opposed - passed (LTC #071-2019)
