#### 1. **Logic and Accuracy Test of the touch screen and optical scan voting systems to be used for Vote-by-Mail, early voting, and precinct ballots.**

##### Action:

- a. On November 14, 2019, at approximately 10:00 a.m., the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections had the tabulating equipment to be used in the City of Miami Beach Run-Off Election publicly tested to ensure that equipment will correctly count the precinct and Vote-by-Mail ballots cast for all candidates, in all offices, in the Miami Beach Run-Off Election to be held on November 19, 2019.
- b. Public notice of the testing of the tabulating equipment (Logic and Accuracy Test (a/k/a L&A Test)) and the Canvassing Board Schedule for the November 19, 2019 City of Miami Beach Run-Off Election was published in the City's webpage, as well as in the Miami Herald and El Nuevo Herald, and updated schedules were also posted in numerous locations at publicly accessible locations in City of Miami Beach buildings. (Posting locations: City Hall, Miami Beach Police Department Headquarters, 1701 Building, Customer Service Center, Flamingo Park PAL, Flamingo Park Tennis Center, Flamingo Park Pool, North Shore Park Youth Center, and Scott Rakow Youth Center.)
- c. Rafael E. Granado, City Clerk, and Judy Hoanshelt, Qualified Miami Beach Elector (Substitute Member), as representatives of the Canvassing Board, attended the public L&A Test, in order to certify to the accuracy of the test, and witness resetting of each device that passed to a pre-election state of readiness in such a manner as to secure its state of readiness until the opening of the poll.
- d. The L&A Test was open to the public, political party representatives, and candidates or their representatives.

- e. Rafael E. Granado and Judy Hoanshelt observed the performance and results of all required tests and verified the correctness of the programs and equipment. The L&A Test consisted of producing / processing a set of pre-determined valid votes for each candidate, as well as one or more overvoted ballots for each contest.
- f. Upon satisfactorily completing the L&A testing, Rafael E. Granado and Judy Hoanshelt compared the test results with the predetermined totals for each candidate, pursuant to the requirements established in Section 101.5612, Florida Statutes. The expected vote counts matched the actual vote counts.
- g. At the completion of the L&A Test, there was delivered to Rafael E. Granado, in a sealed container with seal No. 0051563, the verified L&A reports and test materials. Steps were taken to ensure the security of said materials prior to, during, and subsequent to the election, except when said materials are properly in the possession of the Elections Department staff appointed to conduct the Miami Beach Run-Off Election.

Name Badges - A new State Statute requires that each member, substitute member, and alternate member of the Canvassing board and all clerical help must wear identification badges during any period in which the Canvassing Board is canvassing votes or engaging in other official duties. The identification badges should be worn in a conspicuous and unobstructed area and include the name of the individual and his or her official position. Rafael E. Granado and Judy Hoanshelt wore their identification badge while engaging in their official duties.
