City of Miami Beach Amends Emergency Order

– Lifts Citywide Curfew, Effective Tonight–

Miami Beach, FL –Today, the City of Miami Beach has amended its [Emergency Measures](#), to lift the city’s midnight to 5 a.m. curfew and allow the following to reopen:

- Soccer cage at Flamingo Park, effective today, June 10, 2020
- South Pointe Park (including the pier), effective June 15, 2020

Additionally, effective today, June 10, 2020, the City’s beaches have reopened, subject to Miami-Dade County Emergency Order 23-20, and the following additional restrictions:

- Beaches shall be open to the public between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. only; and
- Coolers, floats and inflatables shall be prohibited.
