**City of Miami Beach Extends State of Emergency Declaration**  
– Through Wednesday, July 1, 2020 –

**Miami Beach, FL** – The City Manager has extended the city's [State of Emergency Declaration](#) and [Emergency Measures](#) through **July 1, 2020**.

Coronavirus COVID-19 is still very active in Miami-Dade County. Businesses must adhere to the mandatory guidelines for re-opening that have been promulgated by both the City of Miami Beach and Miami-Dade County.

Any violation of the City's Emergency Measures may subject the individual, operator, business entity, or organization to arrest and criminal prosecution pursuant to Section 26-36 and Section 1-14 of the City Code. Furthermore, any violation of the provisions of this Order may subject an operator, business entity, or organization to the closure of the establishment for a period of at least 24 hours, or through the duration of the State of Emergency.
