– *Through Wednesday, July 29, 2020* –

Miami Beach, FL – Today, the City Manager has extended the city’s [State of Emergency Declaration](#) and [Emergency Measures](#) through **July 29, 2020**.

Any violation of the emergency measures shall subject the individual, operator, business entity, or organization to arrest and criminal prosecution pursuant to Section 26-36 and Section 1-14 of the City Code. Furthermore, any violation of the provisions of this Order may subject an operator, business entity, or organization to the closure of the establishment for a period of at least 24 hours, or through the duration of the State of Emergency.
