## **City of Miami Beach Prohibits Short-Term Rentals**

- Effective this Thursday, July 16, 2020 -

**Miami Beach, FL** – As the State of Florida continues to experience elevated numbers of COVID-19 cases, the City of Miami Beach has updated its <u>Emergency Order</u> to close and prohibit all short-term rentals in the city, effective, July 16, 2020 at 12:01 a.m.

Short-term and vacation rentals shall cancel all existing reservations, and shall refrain from accepting new guests or making new reservations, until the Order expires or is otherwise amended.
