Presentations, videos or link must include a label noting the name or group, contact person, daytime telephone number, email address, description/title of the presentation and Agenda item title as well as the Agenda item number. Acceptable formats for electronic submission are pdf, ppt, pppt, pps, ppptx, .wmv, .avi and .mov. (Note that pdf is the preferred format for PowerPoint presentations.)
