- I. **Call to Order:** A. Feola called meeting to order at 3:32 p.m.

- IV. **Update on Venetian Street Resurfacing:** Sabrina Baglieri/CIP provided update
- V. **Towing Permits Discussion:** Representation by both towing companies; brief discussion held/motion made:
- JP Morgan moved that the Transportation, Parking & Bicycle-Pedestrian Facilities Committee asks to defer item to next month, that a copy of towing permits be shared with committee and that someone from the City's legal department be invited to meeting – seconded by R. Streim, all in favor/none opposed – motion passed***

- **Art Deco Cultural District:** Josiel Ferrer, Assistant Transportation Director shared PowerPoint presentation; discussion held/comments/suggestions made
  - **Upcoming Commission/Committee Items:** Milos Majstorovic provided brief overview on items: Trolley service resumption; freebee service (services for elderly); amendment #5 to Clear Channel agreement (bus shelters); amendment #10 to trolley agreement; acceptance of joint agreement with MDC – enable cost sharing on Pine Tree/46<sup>th</sup> safety improvements (traffic circle); acceptance on signage plan on beach walk; acceptance on pilot for open slow streets; beach corridor discussion / Baylink connection interim agreement (Board of County Commissioners in October)
- VII. **Other Business:**
- R. Streim: 1<sup>st</sup> Street Redo; Josiel Ferrer to obtain update from Public Works; update to be placed on agenda for next month
- A. Feola: Venetian Causeway at east entrance to Belle Isle & west entrance – something changed with frequency of light (always gets red light); Josiel Ferrer challenge with automated pedestrian signal and light frequency (cycles were reduced/will look into and provide update next month)
- C. Bolado: Meridian/Dade (southbound crossing Dade) – waited to full cycles on bicycle; Josiel Ferrer confirmed bicycle sensors will be installed
