G.O.B.: Nautilus Traffic Calming Project

Project Update - Sept. 17, 2021

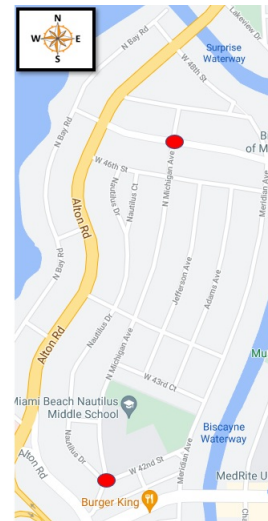
Project Status

The concrete and underground work has been completed for the traffic circle at 47 Street. Debris has been cleared from the work site in preparation for the installation of landscaping and pavement. Beginning on Sept. 20, 2021, the contractor will prepare the soil in the center of the traffic circle for the planting of shrubs and gumbolimbo. Following the planting, the road will be paved and the site will be swept clean. The project is expected to be completed on Oct. 1, 2021.

Work at the traffic circle on 42 Street has been paused to mitigate the impacts to Nautilus Middle School. In addition, the contractor has encountered underground utility conflicts and is revising the design to accommodate these utilities. We will provide additional information regarding the timeline for this project as it becomes available.

Project Benefits

As part of the G.O. Bond, the City of Miami Beach is implementing various improvements in neighborhoods with heavy traffic and frequent speeding incidents. Traffic calming improvements may include traffic circles, speed humps, designated bike lanes and reduced speed signage. During this phase of the project, the contractor will add two traffic circles at neighborhood entry points to reduce excessive speeding as well as cut-through traffic. The scope of work includes hardscape enhancements, new pavement markings, new signage, landscaping and utility adjustments.



The traffic circles will be located on North Michigan Avenue at 42 and 47 streets.

What to Expect

- Pedestrian access and deliveries will be maintained at all times.
- Expect changes to the traffic pattern. Temporary closures and detours may be necessary.
- Moderate levels of construction noise can be expected during the day.
- Construction equipment, machinery and workers will be present at the job site.
- Parking restrictions will be in place and enforced by the Miami Beach Parking Department. Please heed the signage.
- Intersections along N Michigan Avenue at 42 Street and 47 Street will be closed to through traffic for the duration of the construction.

Timeline

Construction work hours are weekdays from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. This schedule may change due to unforeseen conditions or weather.
