- I. **Call to Order:** M. Edelstein, Chair, called meeting to order at 3:31 p.m.

- III. **Approval of March 14, 2022 Meeting Minutes:** *Moved by L. Kolko, seconded by E. Porcelli; minutes approved*
- IV. **Items Requested by M. Gultanoff:**
- **Update on West Ave Project- bike lanes/curb ramps:** Discussion held. CIP was not present, but confirmed they will be presenting to Commission May 18, 2022.
- M. Gultanoff moved that the Transportation, Parking & Bicycle-Pedestrian Facilities Committee strongly recommends West Ave Neighborhood project for aboveground improvements to follow best practices, NACTO standards and Miami Beach 's street design guidelines for pedestrian, bicyclists and driver's safety, seconded by L. Kolko – Five in favor, six opposed. Motion did not pass.*
