- I. **Call to Order:** M. Edelstein, Chair, called meeting to order at 3:31p.m.
- II. **Roll-Call:** *Please see attendance sheet for reference*
- III. **Approval of June 13, 2022 Meeting Minutes:** *Moved by A. Feola, seconded by A. Rabin; minutes approved*
- IV. **Presentation:**
- **Collins Avenue Multimodal Corridor Study:** Dan Hardy- Renaissance Planning and Shereen Yee Fong- FDOT presented. Discussion Held. Presentation will be emailed to Committee.
- V. **Items requested by P. Henao:**
- **Update on County Pilot related to Bicycle Traffic Lights at Euclid and 11th:**
Transportation provided an update. Followed up with County- Pilot was discontinued due to safety issues with parts. Pilot will resume once parts arrive- possibly August.

 - **Plans for E Bay Drive/cause of accidents:** P. Henao advised of two more vehicular accidents that happened this month. Transportation followed up with FDOT. Studies are being done on speed feedback signs, but not in this exact area.
- Transportation advised of plans to construct a sidewalk on the SW side that allows for a safe space on the bridge. J. Gomez with Public Works shared that there are plans currently in the works and should be completed by the end of the month. Will share plans once available.
- VI. **Item Requested by L. Lovell:**
- **Slow Streets 2.0/MDC Approval of 20MPH:** Committee member not present. Item not discussed.
- VII. **Items Requested by M. Gultanoff:**
- **Update on Terminal Island/Bridge Road traffic operations:** Discussion held. Transportation advised that this application went through Planning Board and has been approved. Requested traffic study to be done within six months of construction.
- VIII. **Items Requested by K. Drohan:**
- **Discuss resolution for speeding/traffic on Meridian Ave:** Discussion held. Traffic signal was installed to provide a safe crossing for pedestrians. This is a collector road that may be eligible for traffic calming.
- Transportation will need to collect speed data. Police advised that a mobile traffic sign will be placed on Meridian between 17th and Dade Blvd area within 30 days.

IX. Transportation Department Items:

- **Upcoming Commission/Committee Items:**

- Resolution requested to alter Coast Guard schedule to minimize traffic impacts on 63rd ST bridge.
- Resolution on consent authorizing the City to implement immediate traffic calming improvements for South of 5th neighborhood.

- **Status of Pending TPBPFC Items:**

C. Esquivel requested follow up on request for bike racks near 3rd Street. Transportation will review this area again to locate a space for placement of a bike rack.

X. Other Business

- A. Feola- Traffic Islands throughout the City need relandscaping or to be removed. Requesting an update from Public Works on plans.
- A. Feola would like an update on completion date for streets of Venetian. Transportation to follow up with CIP for an update to present to Committee at next meeting.
- Monica Beltran provided update on Towing Permits. Approved by Commission. New rates go into effect August 1st.
- M. Gultanoff requested bike lanes to be reopened on Dade Blvd canal and 17th ST. Transportation to review MOT and update for completion.
