Transportation, Parking & Bicycle-Pedestrian Facilities Committee Minutes
Monday, September 12, 2022
Hybrid Meeting / Microsoft Teams & In-Person

- I. **Call to Order:** M. Edelstein, Chair, called meeting to order at 3:31 p.m.
- II. **Roll-Call:** *Please see attendance sheet for reference*
- III. **Approval of July 18, 2022 Meeting Minutes:** *Moved by E. Porcelli, seconded by M. Gultanoff; minutes approved.*
- IV. **Presentation:**
 - **Alton Road Project:** Members of FDOT presented and discussion held. Committee followed presentation with questions.
- V. **Item Requested by L. Lovell:**
 - **Slow Streets 2.0/MDC Approval of 20MPH:** Transportation advised this would require a budget enhancement. Discussion held. Residential streets have been approved for 25mph. Transportation continues to have conversations with the County on this project. Transportation to follow up.
- VI. **Items requested by P. Henao:**
 - **Update on County Pilot related to Bicycle Traffic Lights at Euclid and 11th:** Transportation provided update. County is still analyzing data and will provide more information once they have it.
 - **Plans for E Bay Drive/cause of accidents:** Joe Gomez with Public Works shared plans for a walking path on North side of E Bay Drive. Currently conducting internal reviews, expect to be putting out to bid in early December. Expect project to begin in February and end in May 2023.
- VII. **Items requested by A. Feola:**
 - **Update on Venetian Island Improvements:** CIP provided update and advised they have three staging areas for construction to begin. Discussion held. CIP is seeking to move the project as soon as possible.
- VIII. **Items Requested by M. Gultanoff:**
 - **Status of GO Bond Funded 34 St/Chase Ave shared use path:** CIP is awaiting approval from FDOT for grant requirement. Item is on the agenda for the upcoming neighborhoods meeting.

M. Gultanoff moved that the Transportation Parking Bicycle-Pedestrian Facilities Committee reaffirms support for the Chase Ave and 34th ST Shared-Use Path Project. Seconded by L. Kolko – all in favor, none opposed – motion passed (LTC #395-2022)
 - **Update on West Ave Project:** CIP provided update. Project is on hold due to Contractor issues. CIP advised it is their intent to present at October Commission meeting with a final recommendation on the resolution.

- **Update on Transportation & Mobility Dept Budget Requests:** Transportation reviewed budget items. Discussion held. Focus on this upcoming fiscal year budget is safety and emergency services.

M. Gultanoff moved that the Transportation Parking Bicycle-Pedestrian Facilities Committee asks that consideration be placed for the funding of a Bicycle Pedestrian Coordinator position for the Transportation Department. Seconded by R. Jacobs – motion passed (LTC #377-2022)

IX. Items Requested by L. Kolko:

- **Update on Traffic Safety- Collins Ave between 23rd & 24th ST:** Transportation has provided update. FDOT has installed delineator posts in this area. Transportation will follow up with FDOT and provide an update once available.

X. Transportation Department Items:

- **Upcoming Commission/Committee Items:** Transportation advised on resolution for modification of the current Beach Walk Safety Pilot Program.
- Monica advised on referral to the Public Safety and Neighborhoods Committee regarding possibility of having Parking Enforcement Officers on bicycles enforcing bicycle lanes.
- **Status of Pending TPBPFC Items:**
- Safety on 71st bridge- Report was completed on feasibility. Transportation will review and provide comments before it is shared with FDOT (P. Henao)
- Bike Rack still needs to be installed on Washington and 3rd (C. Esquivell)
- East bound right turn lane on Dade Blvd to West Ave. Proper signage and markings that display no right turn. Transportation to follow up with M. Gultanoff (M. Gultanoff)

X. Other Business

- C. Esquivel requested agenda item for next month to discuss enforcement on the boardwalk at South Pointe Park.
