- I. **Call to Order:** M. Edelstein, Chair, called meeting to order at 3:32p.m.

- IV. **Items Requested by E. Porcelli:**
- **Electric Vehicle charging stations in Mid Beach Parking Lot:** Parking advised that FPL is willing to put four chargers but will require transformers. These chargers will be placed throughout the City. This is currently under discussion and could take up to a year to make happen.
- V. **Items requested by M. Gultanoff:**
- **Parking needs at the Miami Beach Botanical Garden:** Discussion held. Parking advised that the Holocaust Memorial will be building a new educational center where the parking lot currently is. Convention Center parking will also be used for parking. This is to be presented at the next Neighborhood meeting. L. Lovell requested a 15-minute parking spot to drop off compost at the Botanical Garden.
 - **Miami Beach Art Week Bike Parking:** Discussion held. M. Gultanoff suggested a Bike Valet be present at all large special events to maintain the bikes. Parking to follow up with the Valet company for a proposal.
 - **Update on bike lane South of 5th on Ocean Drive:** Discussion held. Transportation advised area is still in flux. A proposal for improvement will require a lane study. Transportation to assign this project to a consultant for review. Parking to speak with the security guard to possibly move the umbrella for easy access.
