- I. Call to Order: M. Edelstein, Chair, called meeting to order at 3:31p.m.

## V. Items Requested by A. Feola:

- Traffic Pattern on the Venetian Causeway during construction: Kevin Pulido with Neighborhood Affairs presented traffic plan. Discussion held. Parking to create signage and work with enforcement. Kevin Pulido advised moving forward they will focus on sharing with neighborhood communities and with the Committee in advance of construction projects.
  - M. Gultanoff requested that Public Works restore bike lanes once construction projects are completed. Public Works advised this is done once phases are completed.

#### VI. Items Requested by M. Gultanoff:

- Access path to the beach walk at 23<sup>rd</sup> ST and Collins Ave: Discussion held. Rodney
  Knowles with Public Works has coordinated with Code Enforcement and will be reaching out
  to property owner to begin process of removing and maintaining landscaping.
- Update on Chase Ave/34<sup>th</sup> ST shared use path: M. Gultanoff shared resolution 2022-3246. Discussion held. David Gomez with CIP advised construction permits are under review for approval. Jose Gonzalez advised traffic calming project is currently underway, but still in balloting phase with residents. Transportation to follow up.

 71st ST/ Maimonides Street Business Parking Update: Dani Fawaz with Transportation shared a presentation by consultant in 2019. M. Edelstein requesting short-term resolutions to add more parking spaces to the area. Transportation to follow up.

• Maximum distance separation for Valet storage from the Valet point of service location: Monica Beltran with Parking provided history on this ordinance. Discussion held.

#### IX. Items Requested by C. Bolado:

 Automatic Pedestrian Signals in the City: Discussion held. Transportation advised that automatic pedestrian signals have been removed permanently on 41<sup>st</sup> ST. Transportation tasked to look at corridors on 41<sup>st</sup> ST.

#### X. Items Requested by C. Esquivel:

Traffic light concerns between Harding 87<sup>th</sup> ST and 87<sup>th</sup> Place: Discussion held. FDOT has agreed to build a crosswalk with LED flashing beacons for 2026. C. Esquivel requested for Freebie to add a stop in the route to assist with transportation needs. Transportation to follow up.
