

Flooring Permit Affidavit

All commercial properties, including condominium units, are required to obtain a permit for flooring (tile, wood, marble). To obtain a permit for flooring, please provide the following documents to the permit counter.

- 1) Permit Application
- 2) Flooring Permit Affidavit
- 3) Soundproofing manufacturer's literature with assembly value that complies with the Florida Building Code highlighted
- 4) Floor Plans clearly indicating the area of work
- 5) Copy of a notarized Contract/Agreement between client and contractor may be requested

No trade plan review will be required for flooring permits **except for balcony/terraces, porches, bathrooms, lobbies, and all other public commercial areas.**

NOTE: A soundproofing inspection is mandatory in the City of Miami Beach
