

Flooring Permit Affidavit

All commercial properties, including condominium units, are required to obtain a permit for flooring (tile, wood, marble). To obtain a permit for flooring, please provide the following documents to the permit counter.

1) Permit Application

2) Flooring Permit Affidavit

3) Soundproofing manufacturer's literature with assembly value that complies with the Florida Building Code highlighted

4) Floor Plans clearly indicating the area of work

5) Copy of a notarized Contract/Agreement between client and contractor may be requested

No trade plan review will be required for flooring permits <u>except for balcony/terraces, porches, bathrooms,</u> <u>lobbies, and all other public commercial areas</u>.

NOTE: A soundproofing inspection is mandatory in the City of Miami Beach
