- **Update on Plans for E. Bay Drive:** Public Works provided update- due to the emergency project for Indian Creek at 69th St, schedule for project has been impacted by two (2) months. Plans and permits are expected to be completed by late April 2023. Construction is expected to start late June 2023 and be completed by end of October 2023.
 - **Gridlock at 58th Collins due to FPL Repairs:** Public Works provided update. They have been working with FP and project is scheduled to be completed on February 15th.
 - **Transportation Federal Grants:** Transportation reviewed Federal and State Grants that have been applied for. Recently was awarded SS4A (Safe Streets for All) \$320k for Vision Zero action plan.
