- **Ferry Master Plan: First Last/Mile Connectivity:** Transportation discussed details regarding this topic. Waiting for resolution approval to obtain more details on dock locations, logistics, etc. and will be referred to in the June Commission Meeting.
 - **Upcoming Commission Items:** Transportation briefed on upcoming items.
- VI. **City Department Items (Transportation, Parking, Public Works, CIP)**
- **Update Re- Chase Ave Shared Use Path:** Colette Satchell and David Gomez with CIP – Discussion held. CIP provided update on the project. Committee provided feedback. Construction expected to begin November 2023 and completed in 6-8 months.
 - **FY 23/24 Budget Priorities/ Review FY 22/23:** Transportation advised of June 23rd Budget meeting and is proposing expanding trolley service with 2 new trolleys, On-Demand Free-Bee Svc, Subsidy for Water Taxi, Traffic Signal Optimization Project. Regarding Slow Streets, project is moving forward and proposing Traffic Calming devices, “choke points”, bike lane on Jefferson Ave. Planning to start construction by the end of 2023. Public meeting to be held in July 2023.

- **Member C. Bolado: Second Turn Lane at Indian Creek/41st ST:** Transportation briefed Committee of updates on this matter. Anticipating construction to begin Summer 2024 for 8-10 months. Committee provided feedback.

Bayshore, Palm View, South of Fifth: Transportation updated Committee. Bayshore area project is under review; expected to begin early 2024. Palmview area proposed projects under review. South of 5th speed cushions to be installed within the next few months; still in planning phase. If effective, permanent fixtures to be installed. Committee provided feedback.
 - **Member E. Porcelli: Public EV Charger Update (Parking):** Parking updated Committee. Nine proposals received and are being evaluated. Discussion held.
 - **Member E. Porcelli: Bus Shelters on Indian Creek Drive B/T 27 and 40 Streets:** Discussion held. Transportation will investigate the issue with E. Porcelli. Transportation to provide comprehensive update on this matter during July’s TPBPFC Meeting
 - **Member A. Rabin: MB Traffic & Nextdoor App Questions:** Committee discussion held with Transportation and Parking.

- Transportation to C. Esquivel: Signalization Issue was fixed. C. Esquivel informed the Committee that the wait times are longer. Transportation to follow up.







IX. Other Business:
