



Lincoln Road Lights Replacement Project Continues July 10

Project Advisory sent July 3, 2023

What's Happening

Beginning on Monday, July 10, 2023, street lighting work is scheduled to continue on Lincoln Road between Lenox Avenue and Washington Avenue. The scope of work includes replacing the light fixtures with new, energy efficient LED lamps on approximately 55 Louis Poulsen smaller light poles (example pictured herein).

The city is purposely doing this lighting project ahead of and as part of the Lincoln Road Masterplan project. Design has commenced for Phase 2 Improvements on Lincoln Rd. at Meridian and Drexel Avenues. Further information will be shared as design progresses, prior to construction start.

Timeline

This lighting work will start at Lenox Avenue and crews will work their way east along the north and south sides of the Lincoln Road corridor toward Washington Avenue. It will take approximately one month to complete the new lights. Work will occur on weekdays, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The project team will make arrangements to work at locations close to businesses with table seating at off-peak dining hours. Restaurant managers are encouraged to contact us for further coordination.



Please note, this schedule may change due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

What to Expect

- Equipment, machinery and personnel will be present in the area.
- Two small, electric lifts will be onsite to assist crews with reaching the light fixtures.
- Lights may be temporarily out of order for short periods of time while the new LED lamps are installed.
