<ul> <li>Submit a scaled floorplan that displays all food warming and/or cooking locations and attach a description of proposed cooking/food warming operations.</li> <li>Nonrefillable LP-gas or butane cylinders shall be limited to 1-pound capacity in size.</li> <li>Equipment fueled by small heat sources that can be readily extinguished by water (i.e. candles, Stern permitted when precautions are taken to prevent ignition of combustible materials.</li> <li>Candle flames shall be protected.</li> <li>Cooking devices shall be isolated from the public by a minimum of 48 inches or by a physical barrier.</li> <li>Single-well deep fryers shall have form fitting lids, limited to 2 square feet of cooking surface, pronocombustible surface materials, separated from each other and of any combustible material by a distance of 24 inches. A Class K fire extinguisher shall accompany each deep fryer.</li> </ul>	o) shall be blaced on
The following is a list of safety requirements for use of portable cooking equipment at an <b>outdoor</b> assembly space	ce:
<ul> <li>Submit a scaled site plan that displays all cooking locations, attach a narrative description of cooking operations, and submit flame spread certificate for any tents being used.</li> <li>Cooking tents shall meet flame propagation requirements of NFPA 701, shall not be occupied by the public, and shall have multipurpose fire extinguishers.</li> <li>In addition to requirements previously listed deep fryers shall not be located under a tent canopy an with minimum 16 inches separation from other cooking equipment.</li> <li>All portable cooking appliances shall be protected from general public.</li> <li>Any compressed gas cylinders shall be secured to prevent tipping.</li> <li>Portable generators must be 5 feet from any tent, protected from contact by general public an multipurpose fire extinguisher. *No excess fuel storage permitted.</li> <li>All outdoor open flame cooking operations shall not be within 10 feet of a structure.</li> </ul>	ne general d installed
