(12:00 p.m. to 12:30 p.m.) 3. Canvassing of presumed invalid vote-by-mail ballots (as needed). 4. Duplication of ballots (as needed). 5. Scanning of ballots into an automated independent audit system (as needed). 6. Tabulation of results. 7. <u>Unofficial</u> results.
