- A detailed site plan that includes:
 - A narrative description of the flame effect •
 - The location of the production and audience with separation distance ٠
 - Emergency response procedures and/or safety plan •
- Materials list showing the flammable material, storage, and fuel used for all flame effects.
- Non-refundable permit application fee of \$275.00 paid at time of application submittal.
- Copy of valid driver's license for all flame effect operators.
- Resume of flame effect operator that shows experience with flame effects.
- Certificate of Insurance:
 - Commercial General Liability limits of \$1,000,000 minimum.
 - The City of Miami Beach must be listed as a CERTIFICATE HOLDER and ADDITIONAL INSURED. • The City of Miami Beach must be specifically listed as an Additional Insured.
 - Certificate holder block must display City of Miami Beach 1700 Convention Center Drive Miami Beach, FL 33139.
 - Proof of Worker's Compensation. Companies employing more than (3) three employees are required to carry Workers Compensation insurance per Florida Law.
 - If you do not carry Workers Compensation because you do not meet above criteria you can provide us with a letter stating such exemption.
- Complete permit applications shall be submitted (14) days prior to event.
