

## Flamingo Park Handball Courts

Expected Completion: June 2019

### Project Overview and Benefits

In partnership with the Parks & Recreation Department, the Office of Capital Improvement Projects is renovating the handball courts at Flamingo Park. The renewed courts, created to meet current play and safety standards, will be an available amenity for the Miami Beach community to enjoy.

While the Flamingo Park handball courts are under construction, all avid players are encouraged to use the closest alternate handball courts at Palm Island Park.

### Scope of Work

This project entails:

- Resurfacing, rebuilding the courts
- Adding sports lighting and general lighting
- Repairing stucco
- Installing new frameless windows and doors
- Installing new fencing
- Installing new seating area and water fountains
- Applying fresh paint to the new facility
- Improving drainage
- Removing the existing metal stairway

### Timeline

The handball court renovations should take approximately seven months from start to finish. Construction work is scheduled to begin in mid November 2018. Construction work hours are weekdays from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Extended time is subject to City approval and community notification.

### What to Expect

- A construction fence with wind screen will be set up around the handball court area for safety purposes; all construction activities take place within the fence.
- Vehicles and material deliveries will access the area from Michigan Avenue.
- While construction machinery and workers will be present on the jobsite, road closures are not anticipated for this project.
- Moderate levels of construction noise is expected during the day.
- Flamingo Park handball courts will be temporarily closed while renovations are underway.
