Construction of the new Flamingo Park Handball Courts is complete! The City of Miami Beach is ecstatic to present this long-awaited amenity to our community and the nationwide handball player network.

What's Happening

The city has achieved final completion of the Flamingo Park Handball Courts project. Some associated work, such as resurfacing the service access road, and making final touches will continue prior to the grand opening. That said, the newly renovated handball courts are open for play and the community is encouraged to visit them. Courts are occupied on a first-come, first-served basis for approximately one hour per game.

Project Overview and Benefits

Flamingo Park spans more than 36 acres in South Beach. As funding becomes available, the city will continue to upgrade park amenities to enhance public enjoyment. As various sections of the master plan are completed, residents and visitors will have renovated and new amenities at Flamingo Park to make playtime more fun and functional.

What to Expect

- Work hours are weekdays from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Extended time is subject to city approval. Work is scheduled to take place on some Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Please note, schedules can change due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- The dog parks should not be impacted by this work.
- Parking restrictions may be posted near the construction zone entrances. Please adhere to posted signage to avoid enforcement measures.
