The City of Miami Beach Family Pathways Program is a Children's Trust funded program. We are a collaboration of human service providers, who provide comprehensive, individualized, and accessible wraparound care coordinated services.

WHO QUALIFIES?

Families of children up to 18 years of age, who live or work in the City of Miami Beach and/or whose children attend a Miami-Dade County Public School within the Miami Beach community. For families of children living with a disability who are enrolled in school, eligibility may be up to age 22.

THE TAN CHILDREN'S TRUST

The City of Miami Beach Family Pathways Program is funded by the Children's Trust. The Children's Trust is a dedicated source of revenue established by voter referendum to improve the lives of children and families in Miami-Dade County.
