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- I. **Call to Order:** L. Kolko called meeting to order at 3:33 p.m.

  - Brandon Lloyd with Comm. Suarez – Addressed the Committee with comments and plans on Parking Zones in NOBE. (See Agenda Item Below)
- V. **Special Guest: Commissioner David Suarez**
  - Comm. Suarez addressed the Committee on the proposed NOBE Residential Zone and parking concerns taking place in the neighborhood. He also briefly discussed the proposal for the Reinstatement of Parking Permit Decals. (Refer to City Department Item below)

  - **Upcoming Commission Items**
    - ITN for Municipal Circulator. Will recommend proposed vendors to CM June 26, 2024. (TRANS)
    - Replace Mid-lock Crossing on West Ave between 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> St connecting to the park to a raised crosswalk. (TRANS)
    - Alternative to Bus Route 115 was referred to FERC. Proposing to continue service with LSF. (TRANS)
    - Grading Miami Beach Dr 24<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> St. (TRANS)
    - Recirculation of 41<sup>st</sup> St./Sheridan Ave & Royal Palm Ave to either make them one-way or restrict left turns on 41<sup>st</sup> St. PSNQLC recommended to proceed with 2-way traffic and restrict left turn onto 41<sup>st</sup> St.; intended to start Fall 2024. Will be presented to Commission on June 26, 2024. (TRANS)
    - Proceed to add additional ITS Devices. (TRANS)
    - Reinstitution of Parking Permit Decals; To be voted on during June 26, 2024 Commission Meeting. (PKG)

      - L. Kolko asked if the crosswalk would be raised. Trans. addressed the committee with plans to establish an All-Way-Stop Control at that location. Study is underway and data is being collected to be shared with the County; Response expected in 30-45 days. Discussion held.

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- **Status of Traffic Circle 34th & Prairie (L. Kolko)**
  - *Previously discussed during Jan. 2024 TPBPFC Meeting*
    - Trans. addressed the Committee. Part of the Bayshore Traffic Calming project. There was resident feedback/opposition which was presented to the Commission; Resolution was reached and approved. Discussion held.
- **Completion of Bike Lane from Alton Rd. into Chase Ave. (L. Kolko)**
  - *Previously discussed during Dec. 2023 TPBPFC Meeting*
    - Trans addressed the Committee. Part of the Shared Use Path project. Commission voted on alternative that was approved; CIP is working on redesign to be presented and approved by the Commission. Discussion held.

**VIII. City Department Items (Transportation, Parking, Public Works, CIP)**

- **North Beach Residential Parking Permit Zone (PKG)**
  - A. Ventura addressed the committee and echoed the concerns of Comm. Suarez and B. Lloyd as well as enforcement efforts that will take place. He mentioned that 3 Residential Zones mapped out. The proposal is awaiting Commission approval. J.R. Gonzalez informed the Committee that public hearings will be taking place for each zone during a public meeting on July 24, 2024
  - P. Matos moved to draft LTC in support of establishing a Residential Parking Zone in the 3 proposed areas in NOBE. Motion passed.
