Wednesday's only jackpot winners in the state among Florida Lotto, Cash 4 Life, Powerball and Fantasy 5 were sold in Hialeah and Kendall, according to the Florida Lottery.

The one ticket with the Fantasy 5 midday draw numbers — 1, 3, 8, 21 and 28 — was worth \$54,285.96 and sold at the Kwik Stop at 2581 E. Eighth Ave. (LeJeune Road) in Hialeah.

Quick Pick ticket with 12, 13, 14, 21 and 23 and bought at a Kendall Publix at 16800 SW 88th St. That jackpot paid \$120,132.44.
